

371 Final presentation—Dr. Kloepfer and Dr. Pounds

You and your group will assemble a powerpoint presentation, practice it, and deliver it. You will have a group time limit of 20 minutes (not counting the Q&A session), and every group members must present for a minimum of 5 minutes each. You must email a copy of your group powerpoint to kloepfer_kd@mercer.edu by 2:00 pm on Monday, December 12th. File sizes must be **smaller than 3 MB**. It is your responsibility to have a working powerpoint loaded on the computer in WSC 329 *prior* to our 2:00 pm start time.

You will only be allowed to use your powerpoint slides for this presentation. **No other notes, index cards, visual aids, articles, or references may be used.** (You may have nothing with you on the podium or on the computer screen.)

Your grade for this presentation will be partially determined by group performance (5%) and partially determined by your individual performance (95%). Your individual performance will be determined based on the following criteria: your contribution to the assembly of the group presentation (determined in part by peer and self evaluations) as well as your individual performance during the presentations (both during your own and others). During the presentations, you are expect to ask at least one substantive question of another group. Your group performance portion will be based on the style, cohesiveness, and correctness of your group presentation.

Guidelines for your presentation:

In a convincing way, demonstrate how your metrics can be used to rank aromaticity. You should then rank your compounds, supporting your conclusion with results and discussion.

Because each person is responsible for understanding all components of your project, you may anticipate questions on material you individual did not present.
